## Training Services Policy Updates: Reciprocal Agreements *Effective Immediately*

This Informational Broadcast is to inform all Local Workforce Development Boards (LWDBs) and interested parties of updates to the WIOA <u>Title I-B Training Services</u> <u>Policy</u>. Section **505.06** is being revised as the state of New Mexico no longer has a reciprocal agreement with Arizona. All appropriate updates in this broadcast will be included in the WIOA Title I-B Training Services Policy when it is revised.

## Section 505 - Consumer Choice

## **Subsection 505.06 - Reciprocal Agreements**

Paragraphs A-C are revised under **subsection 505.06** as follows:

- A. The Eligible Training Provider List (ETPL) is the primary list of eligible training providers and programs approved by the LWDBs to be used by the service provider staff when referring a WIOA Title I-B participant to training. Service provider staff may refer to programs on another state's ETPL with which Arizona has a reciprocal agreement if a comparable program is not available on Arizona's ETPL.
- B. Training provider and program information must be manually entered on the Service & Training Plan page in the State system of record.
- C. Service provider staff must enter "Reciprocal Agreement with [the State abbreviation]" in the Training Agent ID field, e.g. "Reciprocal Agreement with MT."
