Revised: Measurable Skill Gains Guide Adult, Dislocated Worker, and Youth Programs *Effective Immediately*

This Informational Broadcast notifies all Local Workforce Development Boards, service providers, and interested parties that the Measurable Skill Gains Guide has been revised for clarity and to reflect updates per <u>TEGL 10-16</u>, <u>Change 3</u>. The guide is now posted on the Title I-B Policy and Procedure Manual webpage. Updates to the Guide include:

- For the Adult and Dislocated Worker programs, clarification that participation in a "training program for a secondary school program" includes a participant in the MSG indicator.
- For the Youth program, clarification that there is no funding requirement for inclusion in the measure, unlike the Adult or Dislocated Worker program.
- Updated link to the list of approved tests used in the National Reporting System for Adult Education.
- Addition of passing a subtest on a State-recognized high school equivalency examination to measure educational functioning level gain.
