Lower Living Standard Income Level (LLSIL) 2020 Matrix
Effective Immediately

This Informational Broadcast is to inform all Local Workforce Development Boards (LWDBs) and interested parties of the intended use of the *Lower Living Standard Income Level (LLSIL) Income Matrix for all Local Workforce Development Areas (LWDAs) for 2020* for the WIOA Title I-B Adult, Dislocated Worker (DW), and Youth programs.

Each year, the Department of Economic Security (DES) disseminates the LLSIL Matrix after income levels are calculated for the metropolitan and non-metropolitan areas. This matrix includes:

- A. The poverty guidelines (poverty line), as published by U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS);
- B. Seventy percent of the LLSIL income levels, as determined by the Department of Labor, Employment and Training Administration (DOLETA); and
- C. Self-sufficient income levels as a percentage of LLSIL, as identified in each LWDB's local plan.
