 - Community feedback
 - Discussed feedback received by Raising Special Kids:
 1. New document received from AzEIP March 18, 2022 indicates that services can be provided in-person
 2. Families still getting push back from service coordinators (SCs)/teams about in-person services
 3. Families are excited that services can be provided in-person again
 4. Therapists not wanting to go back in-person, if family is unable to accommodate virtual visits, then may lose therapist
 - Committee member discussion:
 1. Families can talk to SCs, team members, program supervisor, if needed
 2. Transition back to in-person services may take some time as providers already have visits scheduled
 3. If families prefer virtual services, then this is still allowed, likely to see hybrid combination of in-person and virtual visits
 - Family story for ICC and AzEIP Gerrie's Gazette
