A. For Home and Community Based Programs*

Identification of Three Top Accomplishments

1. The Area Agency on Aging, Region One serves the Phoenix area and Maricopa County. In the spring of 2010 Region One began administrating the Fall Prevention Coalition. The coalition includes 150 individuals with an average of 40-50 in attendance at the regular meetings. Members of the coalition include representatives from local hospitals, home care providers, pharmacists, and medical schools among others. A fall prevention workshop was hosted by a local hospital and covered home modification, physical activities, and medication management. Medical personnel from the A.T. Stills medical school were on hand to demonstrate exercises and to review medications brought in by seniors. The "Hazard House" model was on display showing many fall hazards that could exist in a home. Similar regional workshops will be conducted over the next year. The coalition developed the AZ Stop Falls website for the purpose of providing advice and raising awareness of falls among older adults. The website is updated regularly with current information and has approximately 300 visitors each month.

Type of Development: 2. Resource development

2. The Pinal-Gila Council for Senior Citizens (PGCSC), a rural Area Agency on Aging in central Arizona, in partnership with the Pinal County Behavioral Health Department and SunLife Family Health Care established a resource room for seniors in San Manuel, Arizona. The resource room also serves the nearby towns of Mammoth and Oracle. The combined population of the tri-community area is nearly 10,000 plus the outlying areas. PGCSC staff and department volunteers will be available to provide information, resources and to help older adults with questions on multiple issues of aging. Information and educational materials will be available on Medicare changes, mental and behavioral health issues, prescription medication risks, and other available resources for seniors.

Type of Development: 2. Resource development

3. The Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona (ITCA), an Area Agency on Aging that serves numerous tribes throughout Arizona enhanced its Health Promotion / Disease Prevention Program with a grant from the Administration on Aging. The Chronic Disease Self-Management Program was implemented with ITCA providing two lay-leaders who trained 30 individuals from six tribes. Three individuals have become master trainers. The Powerful Tools for Caregivers (PTC) was also implemented by ITCA. Three tribes were contracted to conduct PTC classes in their communities. Among the contracted tribes there were 12 classes conducted for tribe members. ITCA also provided health related information by distributing literature to over 1,000 seniors on medication management, vision and dental care, cancer, and pandemic outbreaks at the following gatherings: Arizona Indian Council on Aging Conference; the Caregiver Conference; White Mountain Apache Elderfest; San Carlos Apache Elderfest; and the Tohono O'odham Nation Senior Day.

Identification of Three Top Accomplishments

1. The Pinal-Gila Council for Senior Citizens (PGCSC) plays a leadership role in the Elder Abuse Specialist Team (EAST). The team is comprised of representatives from the PGCSC; Adult Protective Services; Pinal/Gila Long Term Care; Central Arizona Council of Governments; local police departments; public fiduciaries; and county attorney offices. The mission of the EAST is to reduce all forms of elder abuse in Pinal and Gila counties through education, coordination, and enforcement of the laws protecting the elderly. The mission is accomplished by increased cooperation among all involved agencies and community awareness of elder abuse through training and education conducted at an annual elder abuse conference sponsored by the EAST.

Type of Development: 1. Public education/awareness

2. The Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona (ITCA) has contracts with three tribes to provide Ombudsman services: Hopi; Pascua Yaqui; and White Mountain Apache. The ombudsmen are certified and are responsible for visiting tribal members that reside in long term care facilities located off reservation lands. The ITCA employs a program specialist who is responsible for coordinating tribal ombudsmen activities and for conducting biannual training sessions, disseminating information, and providing technical assistance. Monthly teleconferences provide a forum to address issues or concerns and provide local ombudsmen with updated federal and state policy information. In the fall of 2009, thirteen community workers from four tribes completed training to become volunteer ombudsmen. The volunteers are employees of Adult Protective Services and home-based services agencies, but visit tribal members who reside in long term care facilities off reservation lands and who are in need of translation and ombudsmen related services.

Type of Development: 7. Other

3. The Western Arizona Council of Governments (WACOG) participates in the Yuma Elder Abuse Task Force. The WACOG is a rural Area Agency on Aging that serves Yuma, La Paz, and Mojave counties. The purpose of the task force is to raise awareness about the issue of elder abuse and inform the community about resources available to seniors. Numerous community organizations participate in the task force. "Operation Medicine Cabinet" was conducted in 2010 to give the opportunity for seniors to drop off expired medications for destruction and personal paperwork for shredding. In the summer of 2010, a fan drive collected and distributed fans to seniors who were at risk of developing a heat related illness. The task force also hosted the showing of the movie, "The Age for Justice". A panel discussion followed the showing with 70 individuals participating. In addition, there were 45 community organizations staffing informational booths. Similar events are planned for 2011.

Type of Development: 1. Public education/awareness
