<p>The Area Agency on Aging (AAA), Region One's Senior HELP LINE took 45,000 calls from the community in FY-17, more than ever before, providing information and resources to older adults, caregivers and the community at large. They also responded to nearly 300 electronic communications, maintained 28 caregiver resource zones and participated in 67 number of community events and presentations.</p>

<p>AAA Region Three developed a menu for capacity building activities that our agency can offer to our provider network to strengthen and build the networks capacity to deliver services and increase their knowledge of business and operations skill sets.</p>		
3	Type of Development:	3. Training/education
<p>Expansion of Caregiver Peer Support in Casa Grande, AAA Region Five –The Casa Grande area has seen a marked increase in the number of family caregivers seeking caregiver support services. During the 3rd and 4th quarters, the number of caregivers attending increased from an average of 12 to an average of 32. We see several factors contributing to the increase in numbers. The first is that the group moved to a location that provides respite care during the meeting. The second is more subjective. The group facilitator, who has been working with this group for 10 years as well as facilitating support groups for nearly 40 years, notes a marked increase in the number of caregivers willing to reach out for support and education earlier in the dementia process. Reasons for this are a willingness to acknowledge the disease and an understanding that seeking information and support may lead to enhanced quality of life for the caregiver as well as the care recipient. Due to the increase in numbers, efforts were made to make the group more manageable and more effective. Adding a second group on a different day did not work as caregivers came to both. Now the group is meeting on the same day at the same building with 2 facilitators in 2 locations with the entire group coming together for 30 minutes for socializing and refreshments. Also, an additional group is being added in a neighboring town that will help some who are traveling to Casa Grande.</p>

<p>The Area Agency on Aging (AAA) Region Three- This year for World Elder Abuse Awareness Day, (WEAAD) our Ombudsman Program partnered with the 7th Day Adventist Church and our local Community Legal Service Inc. who were also conducting on the same date, their "Arizona Sonshine" Event that provided free medical, dental and legal services. Well over 900 community members attended this event at the Prescott Valley Event Center. While community members were waiting to obtain these free services, we had the opportunity to provide public awareness to the social issues surrounding Elder Abuse and the resources to assist in identifying it and reporting it. As a result, this was the largest World Elder Abuse Awareness event in the State.</p>		
2	Type of Development:	1. Public education/awareness
<p>AAA Region One has been participating in an elder abuse prevention project funded by the National Institute of Justice. Under the direction of DC based research group, Urban Institute, the project goal is to build resilience in older adults so they may protect themselves from victimization. The intervention will be a 12-week in-home program, delivered by a licensed social worker. Agency staff attended an advisory council meeting in Washington DC in March of 2017 and a local advisory council meeting was also held in Phoenix in September. The intervention will be pilot tested beginning in January of 2018.</p>		
3	Type of Development:	3. Training/education
<p>The Area Agency on Aging, Region One's Long-Term Care Ombudsman Program worked along with the Maricopa Association of Governments to update the protocol for our response to elderly abuse and exploitation. Various organizations that respond to elderly abuse in Maricopa County, including law enforcement, adult protective services, and the public fiduciaries office, reviewed and updated the protocol this past fall which was originally written over ten years ago. The protocol will be available for training for local agencies and other community members to better understand each organizations role in responding and investigating abuse and exploitation of the elderly. The Agency also worked with MAG on the domestic violence protocols.</p>
