National Core Indicators (NCI) Staff Stability Survey is due TOMORROW, Thursday, June 30, 2016.

Significance of the Survey

This survey is intended for Qualified Vendors serving adults and employing Direct Service Professionals (DSPs). Vendor participation is vital to the Division's ability to create comprehensive policies regarding provider contracts, rates and other provider issues. Due to Arizona's low response rate on the last (2014) NCI Staff Stability Survey, the data collected was not representative of the DSP workforce and provider community. **PLEASE TAKE THE SURVEY** in order to provide representative data!

Highlights of the NCI Staff Stability Survey Report 2014

Although Arizona did not have sufficient participation to consider the results representative, they are still noteworthy.

- **Turnover Rate** Arizona has the second highest (59.7%) turnover rate for DSP's among the responding states.
- **Wages** Arizona has the second lowest (\$9.62) average hourly wage for DSP's among the responding states.
- Vacancy Rate Arizona has the second highest (9.8%) full-time vacancy rate for DSP's among the responding states.
