

Monthly Progress for the Quarter October – December 2023

Comparison of 2022 and 2023 Referrals




The number of referrals DDD sent to VR was higher this quarter than the same time in 2022. There were 58 referrals in October 2023 and 42 in October 2022. There were 69 in November 2023 and 42 in November 2022. For December 2023 there were 66 referrals, where December 2022 had 44 referrals.

Employment Data for October – December 2023

VR helped many members get, learn, and keep new jobs this quarter. A total of 69 worked in October, 54 in November, and 60 in December. The members who kept their jobs:

Worked an average of: 22.9 hours per week in October 22.7 hours in November, and 15.5 hours in December.

Earned an average of: \$14.75 per hour in October \$13.92 in November, and \$15.02 in December.
