# October is Domestic Violence Awareness Month (DVAM)

DVAM evolved from the "Day of Unity" in October 1981, conceived by the National Coalition Against Domestic Violence.

#### 1.5 times

Individuals who are deaf/hard of hearing are 1.5 times more likely to experience intimate partner violence.

### 7.6 times

Women who experience partner sexual violence are 7.6 times more likely to be murdered by their intimate partner.

## Did you Know?

Domestic abuse can happen to anyone, even men. This type of abuse is highly underreported, and the issue arises regardless of sexual orientation.

76% of domestic violence-related homicides in Arizona in 2023 were committed with a firearm.

25% of female survivors report at least 11 days of missed work due to stalking.
