TOPIC: Q2 Survey - One Time Funds to offset Provider Costs

TARGET AUDIENCE: Qualified Vendor

In anticipation of CMS approval, the Department is making preparations for the distribution of this funding. To be eligible for this funding, the Qualified Vendor must have rendered one or more of the selective Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) that received a rate increase due to Proposition 206 passage and be a current DDD provider. In order for an organization to qualify for the first distribution of funds, it must complete and submit a response to the survey available through the following Survey Monkey [link](#). The survey must be completed and submitted by December 2, 2018. If you have any difficulties accessing and completing the survey, you must request and submit a PDF copy through the following [DDD Prop 206 Survey email](#) by close of business December 2, 2018. Additionally, if you would like to view the survey outside of Survey Monkey, you are also welcome to request a copy via that e-mail inbox.

All organizations, even those who are not eligible for one-time funds, are welcome to complete the survey. DDD is interested in understanding the situations faced by all of our Qualified Vendors. However, only Qualified Vendors that have rendered one or more of the selective Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) that received a rate increase due to Proposition 206 passage, are eligible to receive the one time funds.

The first distribution of funds will be based on the total amount of paid claims for the selective HCBS identified for dates of service 7/1/2018 through 9/30/2018, as recorded by December 1,

2018. The distribution of funds will be proportionate to the total amount of paid claims during this time period.
