Methodology

Geography

The summary sheets contained in this document provide various census demographics and Arizona Department of Economic Security (DES) client counts summarized by the Arizona Early Intervention Program (AzEIP) region boundaries, which were created based on ZIP code boundaries as they existed in December 2011.

DES Client and Provider Information

Geographic Information Systems (GIS) software was used to determine the AzEIP region for each client using the client's residential address. In cases where the client's residential address was unavailable, the client's mailing address was used. Client counts are a representation of those who were active during state fiscal year 2014 (July 1, 2013 to June 30, 2014). For more details about the client datasets, refer to the *Data Sources and Descriptions* section starting on page iii.

Demographic Information

All demographic estimates were collected from the United States Census Bureau 2009 to 2013 American Community Survey (ACS) 5-Year Product. The ACS product included estimates derived from surveys collected between January 1, 2009, and December 31, 2013. Since the estimates were based on a small sample size (8% of the total households that existed in Arizona during that time period), the US Census published margins of error with each estimate to help identify the estimate's reliability (US Census 2014a). While this book does not provide the margins of error, they are available online through the US Census American FactFinder website (US Census 2014b). For more details about the census demographic datasets, refer to the *Data Sources and Descriptions* section starting on page iii.

Since the US Census does not calculate demographics for AzEIP regions, the GIS program had to estimate the demographic values for each region. Demographic data was collected at the census tract geography. Where the census tract was completely within a region, the total demographic count was added to the region estimate. In cases where the tract was split between two or more regions, the demographic counts were split between the regions based on the concentration of the population within each tract part. The population concentration was calculated based on the Census 2010 total population counts at the census block level.

As an example, Tract A has 100 people and is split between Region A and Region B. Using census blocks, it is determined that 30% of Tract A's population is located within Region A and 70% of Tract A's population is within Region B. So, 30 people would be added to Region A and 70 people would be added to Region B.

Demographic and Department Client/Provider Reports

The summary sheets include a region rank field and a percentage field. These values were included to help readers better understand the concentrations of the demographics and clients within each AzEIP region and compare those concentrations to other regions in the state.

The region rank field compares the demographic estimates or client counts to the other regions in the state. The field ranks each variable on a scale from 1 to 22, where 1 indicates the most populous. For example, of the 22 regions in Arizona, the Central Maricopa Region has the 13th highest population of residents age 85 and older.

The percentage field for census demographics identify how much of the region's total population are represented by that demographic variable. The fields are labeled based on what base (e.g. population, households, families) the variable is being compared to. For example, in the Central Maricopa Region,

5.1% of the total population in the region was under the age of 3 and 28.9% of the total families in the region were married with children living at home. In the case of the DES client counts, the percentage field identifies the portion of the total statewide client population that is located within each region.

Data Sources and Descriptions

Arizona Department of Economic Security (DES) Client and Provider Datasets

- Arizona Early Intervention Program (AzEIP) Families
 - Families that had children with developmental delays or disabilities and were actively receiving services through AzEIP on June 30, 2014.
 - Source: Arizona Early Intervention Program

- Child Care Authorized Families
 - Families who were authorized to receive child care services as of June 30, 2014.
 - Source: Child Care Administration

- Child Care Subsidy Wait List Families
 - Families who were on the child care subsidy wait list as of June 30, 2014.
 - Source: Child Care Administration

- Cash Assistance Families
 - Families who were active in the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) Cash Assistance program on July 11, 2014.
 - Source: Family Assistance Administration

- Nutrition Assistance Households
 - Households that had at least 1 person active in the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) on July 11, 2014.
 - Source: Family Assistance Administration

- Medical Assistance Households
 - Households that had at least 1 person actively enrolled in the Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System (AHCCCS) Health Insurance program on July 11, 2014.
 - Source: Family Assistance Administration

Demographics

All demographic estimates were collected from the United States Census Bureau 2009 to 2013 American Community Survey (ACS) 5-Year Product.

- Population
 - All people, male and female, child and adult, living in a given geographic area (US Census 2014c).
 - ACS table B03002

- Household
 - All people occupying a housing unit (e.g. house, apartment, mobile home). Occupants may be related (i.e. families), un-related, or a mix (US Census 2012, p. 72).
 - ACS table B19001

- Family
 - Consists of a householder and one or more other people living in the same household who are related to the householder by birth, marriage, or adoption (US Census 2012, p. 75).
 - ACS table B11003

- Household English Proficiency
 - Households that had at least 1 person age 14 years or older who spoke only English or could speak English “very well” compared to households where all members spoke English less than “very well” or not at all (US Census 2012, p. 93).
 - Survey respondents self-identified how well they spoke English.
 - ACS table B16002

- Age Group (Ages 0 to 17)
 - Age classification was based on the age of the person at the time the survey was completed. Survey respondents were asked to round their age down, regardless of how close their next birthday was (US Census 2012, p. 45).
 - This estimate does not include children age birth to 17 who were living in group quarters. Group quarters are places where people live in a group living arrangement that is owned or managed by an entity or organization. Examples include college dormitories, residential treatment centers, and correctional facilities (US Census 2010, p. B-14).
 - This affected 3,533 children statewide, which accounted for less than 1% of the total children living in Arizona.
 - ACS table B09001

- Age Group (Ages 18 and older)
 - Age classification was based on the age of the person at the time the survey was completed. Survey respondents were asked to round their age down, regardless of how close their next birthday was (US Census 2012, p. 45).
 - ACS table B01001

- Ethnicity
 - Estimates include persons who were Hispanic or Latino compared to persons who were not Hispanic or Latino.
 - A person was considered Hispanic or Latino if they identified themselves as being of Cuban, Mexican, Puerto Rican, South or Central American, or other Spanish culture or origin (US Census 2012, p. 70).
 - Ethnicity was independent of the person’s race. People who identified as being Hispanic or Latino could be of any race (US Census 2012, p. 71).
 - ACS table B03002

- Race
 - Estimates include persons who identified themselves as belonging to a specific race group. Persons who identified as being of two or more races were classified in the “Other or Multiple Races” group (US Census 2012, p. 105).
 - ACS table B02001

- Disability Characteristics of Non-Institutionalized Population
 - Estimates include civilian, non-institutionalized individuals who identified themselves as having one or more of the following conditions (US Census 2012, p. 55):
 - Vision: Person was blind or had serious difficulty seeing, even while wearing glasses.
 - Hearing: Person was deaf or had serious difficulty hearing.
 - Cognitive: Due to a physical, mental, or emotional problem, the person had serious difficulty concentrating, remembering, or making decisions.
 - Ambulatory: Person had serious difficulty walking or climbing stairs.
 - The list above is not a complete list of the types of disabilities tracked by the US Census. Additional disability information can be found in Table S1810 in the 2009-2013 American Community Survey 5-Year product.
 - The civilian, non-institutionalized population included persons who were living in households or non-institutional group quarters, which are facilities that house those who are eligible, able, or likely to participate in the labor force. Examples include college dormitories, emergency or transitional shelters, or similar living arrangements (US Census 2010, p. B-16).
 - The estimates do not include military personnel or persons living in institutionalized group quarters, which are facilities that house those who are ineligible, unable, or unlikely to participate in the labor force. Examples include adult or juvenile correctional facilities, nursing or skilled nursing facilities, mental or psychiatric hospitals, in-patient hospice facilities, and other institutional facilities (US Census 2010, p. B-14).
 - ACS table S1810

- Income Level by Household
 - Estimates include the sum of all income received by all occupants of the household (related or not) during the 12 month period prior to completing the survey. Income was adjusted for inflation to 2013 dollars (US Census 2012, p. 77).
 - ACS table B19001

- Poverty Status
 - Poverty status was determined by comparing a person’s total family income (i.e. income received by all related persons in the household) in the last 12 months to the 2013 poverty threshold appropriate for that person’s family size (US Census 2012, p. 102).
 - If two or more families were living in the same housing unit, the poverty status was calculated separately for each family.
 - Children are defined as individuals age birth to 17. Adults are defined as individuals age 18 and older.
 - ACS table B17001

- Population in Civilian Labor Force
 - Estimates identify the employment status for members of the civilian labor force, which included people age 16 or older who were not students, homemakers, retirees, seasonal workers, institutionalized persons, or members of the armed services (US Census 2012, p. 61).
 - ACS table B23025

- Families with Own Children Under Age 18
 - A married or single householder who had at least one child under the age of 18 still living at home. Children were related to the householder either by birth, marriage, or adoption (US Census 2012, p. 73).
 - ACS table B11003

- Educational Attainment
 - The highest level of education received by individuals age 25 or older (US Census 2012, p. 58).
 - ACS table B15002
