

Monthly Progress for the Quarter July – September 2024

Comparison of 2023 and 2024 Referrals




The number of referrals DDD sent to VR was higher this quarter than the same time in 2023. There were 66 referrals in July 2024 and 59 in July 2023. There were 91 referrals in August 2024 and 84 in August 2023. For September 2024 there was a drop in referrals to 78 referrals, where September 2023 had 66 referrals.

Employment Data for July – September 2024

VR helped many members get, learn, and keep new jobs this quarter. A total of 118 worked in July, 109 in August, and 112 in September. The members who kept their jobs:

Worked an average of: 25.8 hours per week in July 23.7 hours in August, and 24.4 hours in September.

Earned an average of: \$14.59 per hour in July \$14.98 in August, and \$16.05 in September.
