### **4.1 Transition Activities**

- 4.1.1 Discussion about transition out of early intervention is an ongoing process that begins when the child is determined eligible for AzEIP and is revisited during each periodic review of the IFSP.
- 4.1.2 Transition planning requires consideration of three specific transition activities: Transition Planning Meeting, PEA Notification, and Transition Conference.
  - A. Refer to Appendix 4: AzEIP Transition Timeline to determine by when each of the transition activities must occur based on the child's age at AzEIP eligibility determination.
  - B. The service coordinator is responsible for ensuring each transition activity is entered in the ADES data system within ten (10) calendar days of the completion of the activity.
- 4.1.3 The purpose of transition planning is to ensure the child's transition out of early intervention is as smooth as possible for the child and family.
