Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act Title I-B
Policy Broadcast
Exits Excluded from Accountability Measures
PB # 17-007
Effective Immediately

This Policy Broadcast is to inform all Local Workforce Development Area staff and interested parties of revisions to WIOA Title I-B Section 100-Adult and Dislocated Worker Programs and Section 200- Youth Program policies related to program exits. The revisions are consistent with Attachment 2, [Table A Exclusion for PIRL Data Element 923 as shown in Training Employment Guidance Letter No.10-16.](#) This broadcast also removes a reference to retirement as it does not apply to youth.

The attachment clarifies:

- Which participants involved in the military are excluded from performance accountability measures;
- That participants who are initially determined eligible and subsequently determined ineligible for WIOA Title I-B program services are **NOT excluded** from performance accountability measures; and
- When youth participants involved with foster care are excluded from the performance accountability measures.

Section 107.A.1.d will be revised to read:

Called to Active Duty - The participant exits the program because the participant is a member of the National Guard or other reserve military unit of the armed forces and is called to active duty for at least 90 days.

Section 107.A.1.e will be removed.

Section 216.A.1.d will be revised to read:

Called to Active Duty - The participant exits the program because the participant is a member of the National Guard or other reserve military unit of the armed forces and is called to active duty for at least 90 days.

Section 216.A.1.e will be removed.

Section 216.A.1.f will be revised to read:

Foster Care - The participant is in the foster care system as defined in 45 CFR 1355.20(a), and exits the program because the participant has moved from the local workforce area as part of such a program or system.

Section 216.A.1.g will be removed.

The revisions in this policy broadcast will be incorporated into the WIOA Title I-B Adult and Dislocated Worker Programs and Youth Program Policies when they are revised.
