PHOENIX – All online DES application services via the DES website will be unavailable on Saturday, April 2, 2016, from 6:00 a.m. to midnight due to required systems maintenance.

Online application services included in this temporary shutdown:

- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) Formerly known as food stamps
- Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) Cash Assistance
- Medical coverage through Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System (AHCCCS)
- Adult Protective Services
