Title VII of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended, provides the authority for the Arizona Statewide Independent Living Council (AZSILC) and the network of Federally-Funded Centers for Independent Living (CILs) to seek public input on priorities and needs related to disability issues to guide the development of the next three-year State Plan for Independent Living (SPIL). The State Plan is supported by the Department of Economic Security, Rehabilitation Services Administration, (RSA).

The SPIL is a plan designed to improve Independent Living services for individuals with disabilities in Arizona. The State Plan also helps to identify the needs and priorities of consumers, providers, and other stakeholders involved in the CIL network to highlight and identify common strategies. Ultimately, the State Plan is a tool that directs the use of Federal IL funding.
