

## **Difference Between Current Rate Schedules and Those Released on May 2, 2003**

The current rate Schedules are different from the rate Schedules published on May 2, 2003. While most of the rates remained the same, the following is a list of differences between the two Schedules:

1. The numbers on the Schedules were changed. The current rate Schedules are organized in the following order:
  - ❑ Schedule 1.2 lists rates applicable for SFY 04 only (phase-in rates),
  - ❑ Schedule 2.2 lists conversion to group home daily rates applicable for SFY 04 only (phase-in rates), and
  - ❑ Schedule 3.2 lists rates that will be in effect starting with SFY 05 (adopted rates).
  - ❑ Schedule 4.2 lists conversion to group home daily rates that will be in effect starting with SFY 05 (adopted rates).

It is assumed that subsequent changes in Schedules will follow this numbering convention. As new schedules are released, they will be numbered to reflect the version (e.g., the next version of 3.2 will be numbered 3.3).

2. Day Treatment and Training rates for adults and children were revised following the Division's review of the program. The new rates may be found in Schedule 1.2 and Schedule 3.2, sub-schedule B. Also, the explanations were conformed to the Amendment 3 of RFQVA 704011.
3. Behaviorally or Medically Intense Day Treatment and Training rates for adults and children rates were added to Schedule 1.2 and Schedule 3.2, sub-schedule B.
4. The unit of service for Flat Trip Rate for Regularly Scheduled Daily Transportation (urban and rural) was revised from "Per Mile" to "Per Trip." The updated rates may be found in Schedule 1.2 and Schedule 3.2, sub-schedule E.
5. Various service codes were updated.
6. All changes to the actual Rate Schedules are highlighted.
