Out-of-School Youth Criteria (OSY) §681.210		
Ages	School Status	One or more of

(Note: Youth who are within the age of compulsory school attendance and have not attended school within the most recent complete school year calendar quarter is an additional criteria for OSY listed in WIOA §681.210, but is not listed above. Per ARS 15-802, compulsory school attendance ends when the youth turns 16 years old, so this criteria does not apply in Arizona.)
